Grade 10th Board Examination Results of the Session: 2022-23.

- Total number of students appeared in grade 10th examination was 162.
- Pass percentage was 100 percentage
- Total number of first division was 152.
- Number of distinctions 92.
- 90 percentage and above- 24 students .
- Mahak Jaiswal of class 10 th topped the examination with 97.6 percentage followed by Anshika Bhand securing 96.6 percentage and Khushboo Chelani with a 96.2 percentage.
- Neelisha Barfa ,Anshika Bhand , Pragya Gautam and Mahak Jaiswal have secured hundred percentage marks in Social Science .
- Neelisha Barfa and Mahak Jaiswal have also secured hundred percent in Marks in IT.

Grade 12th Board Examination Results of the Session: 2022- 23:

- Total 127 students appeared in the 12th grade examination.
- Pass percentage was hundred percentage.
- 118 students secured first division
- 78 students secured distinction.
- 25 students achieved 90% and above.
- Ruchi Fatechandani of Class 12th topped the examination with 96.2% followed by Vaidehi Bhat securing 95.8% and Ashmeet Kaur Tuteja with a notable score of 95.6 percentage.
